HYBRID VARIETIES

	Brianna Elmer Swenson cultivar 7-4-76 named by Ed Swanson at Cuthills Vineyard. White, Medium sized clusters and berries that produce nice pineapple aroma and flavor in the wine. Very cold hardy and shows good fungal resistance.	\$3.10
	Cayuga White Productive and vigorous hybrid. Produces a fruity white wine of good quality. Availability: Available	\$2.65
	Chambourcin Red French Hybrid, produces a highly rated red wine. The vines are productive. Requires long growing seasons on good sites.	\$2.60
	Chardonel A white hybrid with Chardonnay parentage. Good cold hardiness and vigor from the Geneva Breeding Program. Excellent wine cultivar.	\$2.75
	Couderc Red French American Hybrid. Produces a quality red or rose wine. A good candidate for high vigor sites or may require rootstock to improve vigor.	\$2.70
	DeChaunac Very cold hardy (-15 deg. F) and vigorous Red Hybrid used for fair quality red and rose wine.	\$2.60
	Espirit White wine grape with mildly fruity flavor. Makes excellent wine & is a good table grape. Ripens in mid-September. Much like Villard Blanc, one of it's ancestors, only cold hardier.	\$3.30
	Frontenac Extremely winter hardy (-30 deg. F) and disease resistant Red Hybrid from the Univ. of Minnesota Breeding Program. High quality full bodied red wine.	\$2.85
	Frontenac Gris A "sport" of the Frontenac cultivar from Univ. of Minn. Breeding Program. The same as Frontenac in all aspects but produces a "Gris" colored fruit.	\$3.30
	La Crosse A white American Hybrid with Seyval parentage from the Swenson Breeding Program. Very cold hardy and vigorous. Suitable for wine or juice production.	\$2.85



HYBRID VARIETIES (cont'd)
**Lacrescent**

From University of Minn. Breeding Program. This White grape cultivar has excellent wine quality with apricot flavors. Very good cold hardiness. (-25 to -30 deg. F.)

\$3.35**Leon Millot**

An early ripening black grape which makes a wine with a distinct berry aroma. Sister variety of Marechal Foch only ripening two weeks earlier and more productive.

\$2.65**Marechal Foch**

Red French American Kuhlmann Hybrid. Good Burgundian Style wine. Cold hardy (-20 deg. F). Disease tolerant.

\$2.65**Prairie Star**

A nice white wine, cold hardy (-40 deg. F.) variety from the Swenson breeding program. (formerly ES 3-24-7) This cultivar is reported as having good disease resistance.

\$3.10**Rougeon**

Very cold hardy and productive Red with good wine qualities, excellent color.

\$2.60**Sabrevios es 2-1-9**

Sister variety to St. Croix, only more reliable and disease resistant. Grown extensively in Canada makes a medium bodied complex red wine with good tannins. Hardy to zone 4a.

\$2.85**Seyval Blanc**

Productive with medium cold hardiness. An excellent white wine variety.

\$2.60**St. Croix**

Extremely cold hardy (-40 deg. F) Red Swenson Variety. Used for a wine or dessert grape.

\$2.80**St. Vincent**

Red Hybrid with good wine qualities. Cold hardy cultivar that ripens late season.

A white hybrid with Gewurztraminer parentage from the Geneva Breeding Program. Vigorous and productive with wonderful wine qualities.

Extremely cold hardy vine (-70 deg. F.) from S. Dakota State Univ. Breeding Program.
Red wine or table grape capable of low acids and high sugar content.

Vidal Blanc

A white hybrid and heavy producer. Used for white wine production. Medium cold hardiness.

Hardy white cultivar produces high quality dessert or dry wine.
